COVID-19 DATA DASHBOARD

As the Tri-County School Corporation attempts to provide transparent data, a new [data dashboard](#) has been created and posted on our school website. The purpose of the dashboard is to provide information on the number of active cases within the school corporation. The dashboard also provides information on the number of active close contacts.

This information is used by the school corporation to make decisions on possible school closures. As the dashboard shows, the number of positive cases at Tri-County Intermediate and Tri-County Primary since the beginning of the school year is minimal in each building. While the number of cases at

the Jr/Sr high school is higher than the two elementary schools, the determining factor in the temporary closure was the number of students and staff impacted by the contact tracing.
