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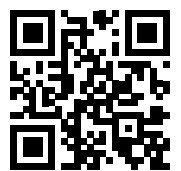

Back-to-School Night

TCP's Back-to-School Night will be on Monday, August 10, from 5:00-6:30 p.m. This is a great opportunity to meet your child's teacher and drop off their supplies before the first day of school. In order to lessen congestion in the classrooms and allow the staff more time to connect with families, we are asking that families with last names A-K come 5-5:45 and families L-Z come 5:45-6:30. We do understand if work or schedule conflicts do not allow you to adhere to that.

At our Open House night everyone will receive a last name sign to display in the car window for pick-up. It is very helpful to us if those name signs are used so dismissal can run as efficiently as possible.

Delayed Start on Wednesdays at TCP

On Wednesday mornings classroom teachers will have professional development time from 7:45-8:45 a.m. at TCP. This professional development will not impact bus schedules; our buses will run on the same schedule, however, students who are car riders have the option to arrive at 8:45 each Wednesday. Breakfast is still served until 8:20 on Wednesdays. Our professional development Wednesdays will begin on August 26.

No Homework Policy at TCP

TCP is a no homework school. Instead of sending homework each night, we asked that our students:

- read or be read to for enjoyment for at least 20 minutes
- go outside and play
- get a good night's sleep

We are hoping this will allow you to spend more time as a family, foster a love for reading and allow students to pursue other interests. While no extra assignments will be given, it is possible that students may take home unfinished work from the day to complete.

ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL TIMES

Both Tri-County Primary and Tri-County Intermediate schools begin by 8:20 a.m. and dismiss by 2:55 p.m. Doors to both schools open at 7:45 a.m. for walkers and car riders to enter through the main entrance. If your child walks to school, please do not have them arrive before 7:45 as there is no supervision before that time.

Breakfast is available to students from 7:45-8:20. If your child arrives at school after 8:20 they are considered tardy for the school day.

The final bell rings at 2:55. Bus riders are taken to their bus or to the cafeteria to wait for their bus. Car riders will be walked to their vehicle by a staff member. If you are picking up your child, please stay in your vehicle in the front drive.

DROPPING OFF AND PICKING STUDENTS UP AT TRI-COUNTY INTERMEDIATE

- Drop off (7:45-8:20) and pick up (2:55) will be through the gymnasium doors.
- Vehicles will enter the ONE WAY drive from Second Street and exit onto North Street.
- Students who arrive after 8:20 will need to go to the office through the new main entrance, also accessed by the new drive.
- Bus loading will continue to be from Door 3 in the asphalt lot off School Street.



JR.-SR. HIGH START AND DISMISSAL TIMES

The Tri-County Jr.-Sr. High School begins its first block by 8:10 a.m. and school is dismissed by 3:10 p.m.

BUS SAFETY

Parents and guardians, please review these bus safety guidelines with your children. Thank you for your partnership in this!

- Stay seated at all times
- Be silent at railroad crossings
- Enter and exit the bus only when the stop arm is extended and the bus is completely stopped
- Be courteous of the driver - no shouting, screaming or rough play
